What is COR?




A Certificate of Recognition (COR) is awarded to employers who have successfully implemented a **Health** and **Safety Management System** that is evaluated by an audit process and meets Partnership's standards. COR is issued by the Alberta Government and co-signed by Certifying Partners like the CCSA. As a Certifying Partner, the CCSA will help you get COR and start reaping the rewards!

Health & Safety Management System (HSMS)

The 8 elements of HSMS required for COR are:

- 1) Management, leadership and organizational commitment
- 2) Hazard identification and assessment
- 3) Hazard control
- 4) Workplace inspections
- 5) Worker competency and training
- 6) Emergency response planning
- 7) Incident reporting and investigation
- 8) Program administration
