2020 was another extremely busy year for the CCSA as we worked diligently to deliver on our member’s mandate:

- Industry-specific health and safety training
- Industry-specific health and safety consultation

Industry-specific health and safety training

- Total number of participants trained

While participation in in-person and live, virtual training programs was significantly impacted by the public health emergency, registration in CCSA’s free, on-demand webinars continued to grow in 2020.

Industry-specific Health and Safety Consultation

- Partnered with a CCSA member organization to pilot and deliver critical health and safety orientation for their new employees.
- Partnered with a CCSA member organization to complete a comprehensive review and revision of their formal hazard assessments and safe work practices including hazard assessment and control workshop delivery to their formal hazard assessment teams.
- Partnered with a two CCSA member organizations to present CCSA’s Harassment and Bullying and Mental Health and Wellness in-services during their employee conferences
- Continued implementation of the Industry Advisory Council, membership has grown to ten representatives from CCSA member organizations.
- Partnered with ASCHA to host three Collaborative OHS Member Discussions, with four more planned for 2021.

Industry-specific Health and Safety Information

- Successfully launched a newly designed CCSA website.
- Successfully implemented the CCSA Health and Safety Toolkit.
- Continued to analyze and improve the CCSA monthly newsletter to better present and share industry-specific information.
- Development of a CCSA Member Introduction Package which will be posted on CCSA’s website.



Partner in Injury Reduction/ Certificate of Recognition Program Administration

- Conducted 17 COR Certification/Recertification audits for CCSA members.
- Implemented a new audit registration system.
- Partnered with an external vendor to offer a software-based audit tool, AuditSoft, which offers an additional option and compliments CCSA's free, excel-based Audit Tool providing options to CCSA members and auditors.
- Trained approximately 26 new internal and external auditor candidates
- Reviewed approximately 65 – 2020 audits (including corrections & qualifying auditors)
- Continued to improve CCSA COR administration internal processes.
- Continued to improve CCSA COR communications and COR Holder outreach.
- Added capacity for CCSA CP Staff Auditors.
- Added capacity for CCSA Audit Quality Assurance Reviews.
