

Workers and Volunteers, do you know your 3 basic OHS rights?

1

The Right to Know about workplace hazards and to have access to health and safety information at the work site.

2

The Right to Participate in health and safety discussions and in decision-making on matters that affect your health and safety at work.

3

The Right to Refuse Dangerous Work if you have reasonable grounds to believe the work is dangerous to you or any other person.

Your employer cannot take discriminatory action (such as termination, layoff, demotion, transfer, change in job location, etc.) against you for exercising your rights and duties under the law.
