



What is a Certificate of Recognition (COR)?

Employers who have successfully implemented a Health and Safety Management System that meets Alberta's Partnership's standards can participate in the COR process.

Why participate in COR?

It makes good financial sense

WCB rebates of up to 20% Lower WCB premium and industry rate

Reduced cost associated with employee incidents

Assists in meeting or exceeding legislative compliance Improved productivity

Improved health & safety culture and participation

There are 10 elements of a health & safety system for COR

- 1. Management Leadership and Organizational Commitment
- 2. Hazard Assessment
- 3. Hazard Control
- 4. H&S Committees/Representatives
- 5. Qualifications, Orientation & Training
- 6. Other parties at or in the vicinity of the work site
- 7. Inspections
- 8. Emergency Response
- 9. Incident Investigation
- 10. System Administration

Did you know....

That a majority of the elements of COR are required under legislation, your health and safety system may already meet COR requirements
