Emergency Response is the systematic response to an unexpected or dangerous occurrence that can happen in the workplace.

The goal of any emergency response procedure is to mitigate the impact of the event on people and the environment.

Start out the discussion by setting the expectations for creating a safe space and being respectful of everyone's feedback. Gather your organization's Emergency Response Plans. Watch the short video on <u>Emergency Preparedness</u>. After everyone is done, use the guiding questions to facilitate a group discussion.

Guiding Questions:

- Why is it important that we prepare for emergencies?
- What emergency preparedness plans do we utilize?
- How prepared do you feel to handle a workplace emergency?
- Which emergency do you feel most prepared for?

Note to Team Leader:

 Facilitate an atmosphere of support and openness by encouraging the staff to share openly what they know or don't know without fear of reprisal.
Encourage staff to ask questions. We want staff to ask questions now then be in the emergency and not know what to do.
