Emergency Response is the systematic response to an unexpected or dangerous occurrence that can happen in the workplace.

The goal of any emergency response procedure is to mitigate the impact of the event on people and the environment.

Start out the discussion by setting the expectations for creating a safe space and being respectful of everyone's feedback. Print out a copy of the <u>Code Grey Handout</u> and have your organization's procedure to reference during the discussion. Choose a scenario and read the scenario to the group without telling them the code. Then use the guiding questions to facilitate a group discussion.

SAFETY SEGMENT DISCUSSION

Guiding Questions:

- What code would we call in this situation?
- What is the first thing that we would do at the site in this situation?
- What are the other steps that we would follow?

Notes to the Team Leader:

 Facilitate an atmosphere of support and openness by encouraging the staff to share openly what they know or don't know without fear of reprisal. Encourage staff to ask questions. We want staff to ask questions now then be in the emergency and not know what to do.
