SAFETY SEGMENT DISCUSSION

Guiding Questions:

- Following the shelter suggestions in the video where would we shelter here?
- If residents were on an outing how would you keep them and yourself safe?
- What are some of the early signs that a tornado could form?
- How can one receive timely notifications of local emergencies?



Note to Team Leader:

- Facilitate an atmosphere of support and openness by encouraging the staff to openly share what they know or don't know without fear of reprisal. Encourage staff to ask questions. We want staff to ask questions now then not know during the emergency.
