We're excited to announce that we are working on our Psychological Health and Safety Program. We will soon be offering <u>The Working Mind Course</u>, an evidence-based program designed to promote mental health and reduce the stigma around mental illness in the workplace.

The Working Mind (TWM) is part of the Opening Minds initiative, managed by the Mental Health Commission of Canada (MHCC). It has been adapted to fit the general workplace audience and for LTC frontline workers who have been deeply impacted by COVID-19.
