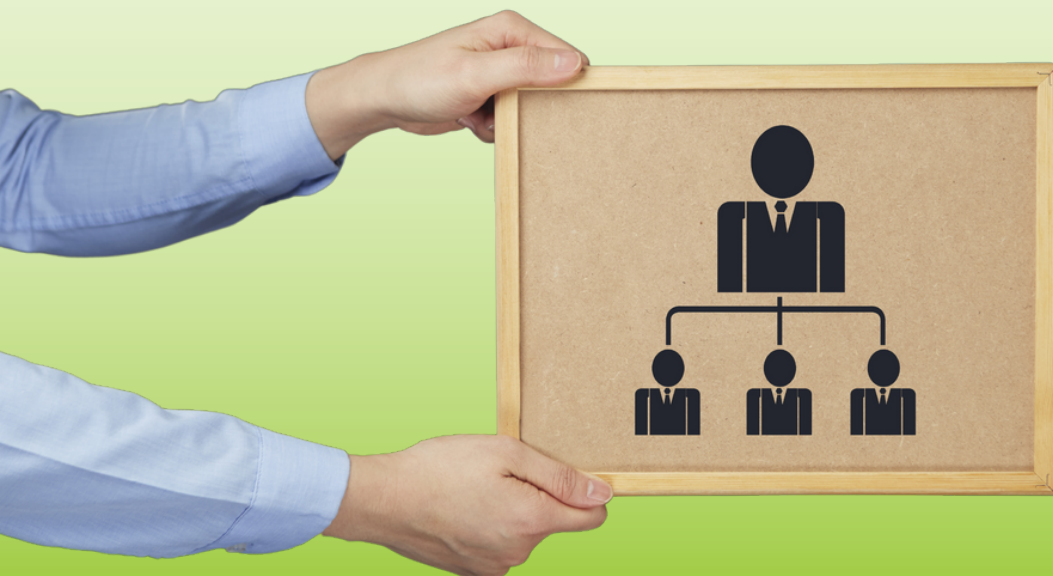


GENERAL HEALTH AND SAFETY RESPONSIBILITIES: SUPERVISORS

Supervisors are to:

- Ensure they are competent to supervise their workers
- Protect the health and safety of workers they supervise
- Make sure supervised workers work in a healthy and safe manner and follow occupational health and safety legislation
- Make sure workers are not subjected to or do not participate in harassment and violence
- Make sure supervised workers use all hazard controls and wear personal protective equipment designated or provided by the employer
- Advise their workers of all known or reasonably foreseeable workplace hazards
- Report health and safety concerns and conditions to their employer
- Co-operate with any person exercising a duty under the occupational health and safety legislation
- Comply with the occupational health and safety legislation



Part 1 of the Occupational Health and Safety Act defines the roles and responsibilities of each work site party
