GENERAL HEALTH AND SAFETY RESPONSIBILITIES: WORKERS

Workers are to:

- Protect their own and others' health and safety at or in the vicinity of the work site
- Co-operate with their employer or supervisor by following health and safety rules for the job
- Use all hazard controls and wear personal protective equipment designated or provided by the employer
- Refrain from causing or participating in harassment and violence
- Reporting health and safety concerns and conditions to their employer or supervisor
- Co-operate with any person exercising a duty under the Occupational Health and Safety legislation
- Comply with the occupational health and safety legislation
