WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Alerts personnel to smoke and/or fire and details the actions to be taken by staff to ensure the safety and security of themselves, their clients and visitors.

If you see or smell smoke:

• Activate the fire alarm (fire pull station) and investigate the origin of the smoke

WHAT DO I DO?

- If you discover fire, follow R.E.A.C.T.
 - **R**–remove those in immediate danger
 - E-ensure rooms doors are closed
 - 0 **A**–activate the fire alarm
 - **C**-call 911 0
 - 0 **T**–try to extinguish or control the fire

Staff in the affected area:

• Follow R.E.A.C.T. if not already initiated

Staff responding to support the area in alarm:

- Assist staff in moving all persons away from the immediately affected area.
- Identify and locate all evacuation devices in case of escalation (e.g. sleds, stretchers, wheelchairs)
