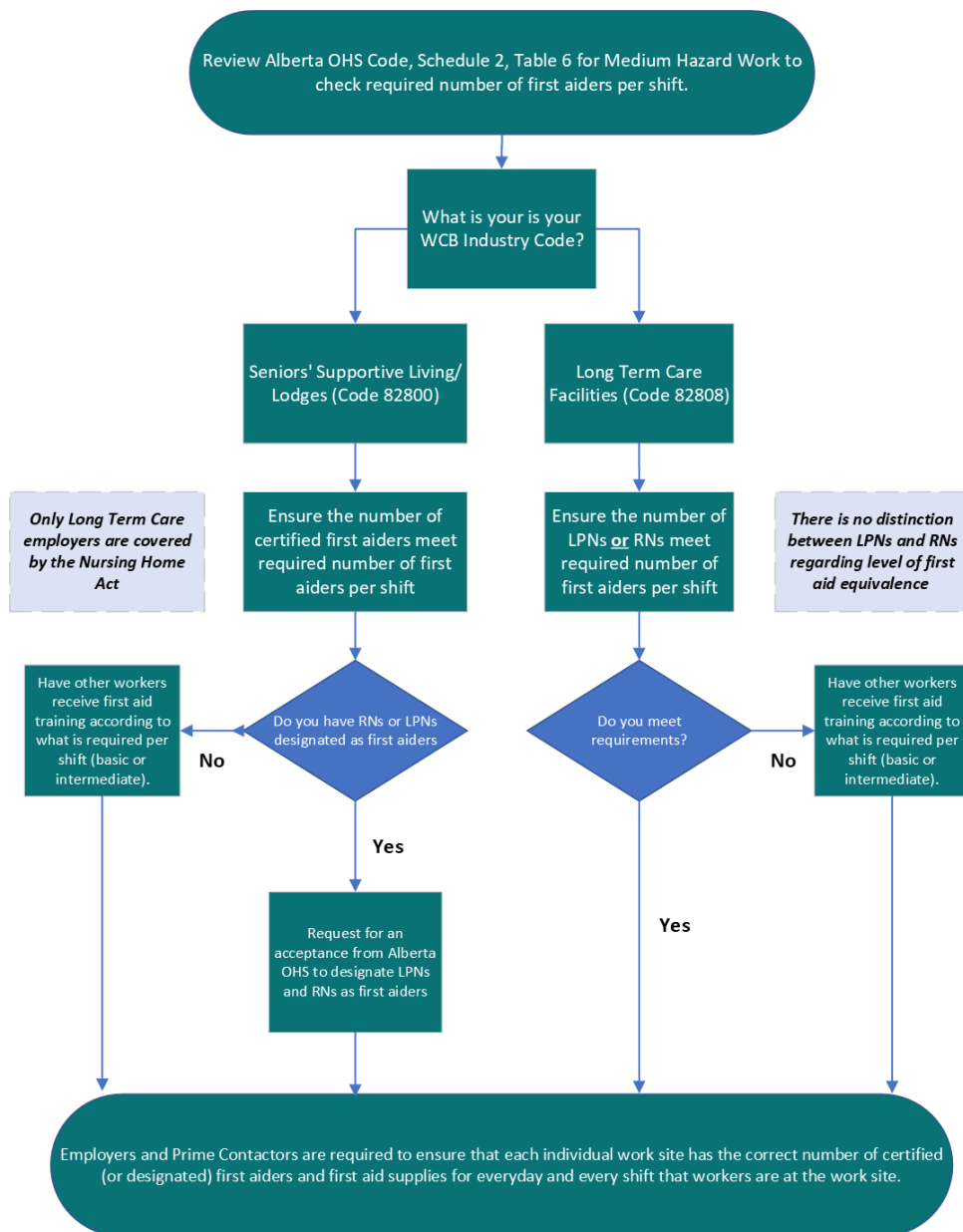


Alberta OHS Code First Aid Training Requirements in Continuing Care

As of March 2023, in a hospital, medical clinic or physician's office, or a nursing home as defined in the Nursing Home Act, where a physician, nurse or licensed practical nurse is always readily available, additional first aiders are not needed. However, the number of RNs or LPNs should still meet the requirements as Schedule 2, Table 6 (Medium Hazard Work).

For due diligence: Employers are encouraged to establish a CPR training schedule for RNs and/or LPNs so they are adequately trained to respond to incidents, and ensure that CPR training is completed as per schedule and/or as required by the Continuing Care Health Services Standards (CCHSS).
