Booking an External Auditor for COR Certification and Recertification

Audits

For organizations who wish to certify, or are in a re-certification year, ensure to book an external auditor soon, as many audits are conducted at the end of the year. Visit our Certified External Auditor list and contact an auditor of your choice for a quote!

Tips for AuditSoft

• **To practice an audit:** For practicing an AuditSoft audit, ensure to enter EVALUATION in the legal name, which opens a mock/sandbox environment for auditors to practice auditing. Remember, you cannot submit a real audit with an evaluation license.




- To start a real audit: For starting a real AuditSoft audit, your audit must be registered on the CCSA's website and accepted by the COR team before you can request the actual license. To request a license for a real audit, ensure to enter the correct organization name under Legal Name.
- All CCSA certified auditors are strongly encouraged to attend the free AuditSoft tool training through SafetyVantage. The online AuditSoft tool training can be accessed <u>here.</u>
- The <u>AuditSoft Help page</u> is full of useful articles for how to use AuditSoft! If your AuditSoft tool support question is not answered on the Help page, please use the <u>New Support Ticket button</u>.


COR Audits by the Numbers

Auditor Training Orientation - OnDemand Course
