### WCB Policy Consultation

The ITF Policy Consultation Subcommittee met on August 12<sup>th</sup> to discuss member feedback on the consultation document and draft recommendations for discussion at our quarterly meeting on September 11<sup>th</sup>. Thanks to members who provided comments.

The subcommittee felt additional clarification would be beneficial. We have sent our questions to WCB and are currently awaiting a response. If necessary, an information session will be scheduled in September.

#### **Industry Custom Pricing (ICP)**

Repolling is underway for participating employers in the Construction and Oil & Gas sectors. A list of Industry codes WCB is repolling in 2024 is attached. If you are in one of these industries and have not received your repolling letter contact WCB. In the fall, WCB will finalize a plan for the other sectors.

WCB indicated they incorporated feedback from ITF, along with their own insights, to make final changes to the letters and fact sheets. They believe the revised letters are more concise and easier to understand, while providing balanced and sufficient information for an employer to decide on continued participation in ICP.

ITF requested clarification about polling options specific to the ability of a group to change the cost relief option (e.g. opt out of waiving cost relief) but still continue in ICP. WCB replied that at the June ITF meeting when asked about the options employers would be re-polled on, they indicated they would be polling industries on the ICP option they were participating in and have followed this approach. This is an agenda item for the September 11<sup>th</sup> meeting, and members will have an opportunity to comment on the repolling process thus far.

# Psychological Injury Working Group (PIWG) Definitions Project Team

The ITF subcommittee met on August 21<sup>st</sup> and the project team on August 23<sup>rd</sup>. WCB completed a review of examples members provided to illustrate the problems with current information regarding psychological injury

restrictions. WCB has taken steps to improve the level of detail outlined in work restrictions by providers (return-to-work services and community psychologists). The group is also finalizing definitions and working towards reaching a common understanding of barriers versus restrictions, which was a priority issue for this team.

### Cognitive Job Demands (CPJDA) Project Team

This PIWG project team met on August 26<sup>th</sup>. WCB advised that 2024 CPJDA metrics have both been exceeded and feedback from providers is positive. Year to date, 31% of new primary psych injury claims have a CPJDA C1447 Form available (target was 10% to 15%). The total number of CPJDAs received for primary psychological injury claims has increased to over 450 from the baseline of 63. WCB continues to assess data availability for other metrics, including those to demonstrate the effectiveness of the CPJDA in improving return to work outcomes.

Care plan and update letters were recently modified to introduce language around how the CPJDA is intended to be used, and website resources and expanded training opportunities for various groups including physicians and nurse practioners continues.

### **Upcoming ITF Association meetings**

The next guest presentation webinar is on Wednesday September 4<sup>th</sup> starting at 1:00. Refer to the September 2<sup>nd</sup> emailed update for the link and an revised agenda.

WCB will provide an overview of the DRDRB role and current processes as the first topic. Dr. Vennala Thumula with the Workers' Compensation Research Institute will then present her research on Psychological Risk Factors and Functional Recovery. The Claims Management Roundtable will follow. Dr Peter Smith with the Institute of Work & Health will close the webinar with a discussion on his research regarding how return to work differs for psychological injury claims.

The next quarterly meeting and ITF Annual General Meeting is on Wednesday September 11<sup>th</sup>. The quarterly meeting starts at 8:30 am and the AGM will begin shortly after. The in-person meeting is at the Manufacturers Health & Safety Association in Rocky View.
