

HOLIDAY ELECTRICAL SAFETY TIPS

INSPECT YOUR ELECTRICAL DECORATIONS: DAMAGED DECORATIONS CAN POSE A FIRE HAZARD, SO IT'S ESSENTIAL TO ENSURE THEY ARE IN GOOD CONDITION.



USE APPROPRIATE OUTDOOR LIGHTING: IF YOU'RE DECORATING THE EXTERIOR OF YOUR HOME, MAKE SURE TO USE OUTDOOR-RATED LIGHTS.

PROPERLY PLACE EXTENSION CORDS: AVOID RUNNING EXTENSION CORDS UNDER RUGS OR CARPETS, AS THIS CAN CAUSE OVERHEATING AND CREATE A FIRE RISK.



DO NOT OVERLOAD ELECTRICAL OUTLETS: IT'S TEMPTING TO PLUG IN MULTIPLE DEVICES AND DECORATIONS, BUT USE POWER STRIPS WITH SURGE PROTECTORS TO DISTRIBUTE THE LOAD SAFELY.

BE CAUTIOUS WHEN DECORATING NEAR WATER SOURCES: WATER AND ELECTRICITY DON'T MIX WELL, SO TAKE EXTRA PRECAUTIONS IN DAMP ENVIRONMENTS.



HIRE A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN FOR ELECTRICAL WORK: THEY WILL ENSURE THAT EVERYTHING IS UP TO CODE AND SAFE.
